1 次の英文は、中学生の Erina が英語の授業で書いたスピーチの原稿である。読んで、あとの問いに答えよ。

Do you know *Kako Satoshi? He wrote many picture books. One of his famous books is *Daruma-chan to Tengu-chan*. When I was a child, I enjoyed it. It is popular among children because its pictures are simple and cute. And the story is funny and interesting. In my elementary school, my *homeroom teacher read another book of his to our class and taught us that Kako Satoshi was from my city, Echizen City. When I knew that, I became interested in him and wanted to read more of his books. So, I went to the library. I was surprised because there were many books written by Kako in the library. Actually, he wrote more than 500 books in his life. From many of his other books, I'd like to tell you about the book *Aki*. It means autumn in English. *Aki* is not as famous as *Daruma-chan to Tengu-chan*, but I like this book because it taught me an important thing.

At the beginning of the book, there are many beautiful pictures of flowers, mountains and the sky in autumn. In the book, Kako says:

"My favorite season is autumn because flowers are beautiful and the air is *clear and fresh. I have another reason. I can enjoy a lot of delicious fruits in this season. I have loved autumn since I was a child. However, in 1944, I couldn't love the autumn because that was a terrible year."

"At that time, I was eighteen years old. Japan was in the war against America. I was a high school student, but I couldn't take any classes. Instead of studying at school, the students of my school had to make *tanks at a *factory. One day in summer, I had a stomachache when I was working at the factory. I went to a hospital and met two doctors there. They said that I needed to have an operation. After the operation, I got better little by little thanks to the doctors and the nurses. One day during my stay in the hospital, one of my doctors got a letter. The letter told him to go to the war. I wanted him to survive, but he didn't."

"On a sunny day in the autumn, I saw an American *fighter plane and a Japanese fighter plane. The Japanese fighter plane was *attacked by the American one. The Japanese pilot died. In the war, many people lost their lives like my doctor and the pilot in the fighter plane. When I thought about their death, I felt very sad and very angry."

"In autumn, the cloudless sky is beautiful. However, in 1944, I couldn't think that the sky was beautiful because people were fighting in that sky. I couldn't love the season in 1944. I hoped the war would end and the world would become peaceful. I really hoped so. Finally, Japan lost. Since then, every year, beautiful autumns without wars have come around."

I would like to introduce this book to many people, not only to children but also to young people like me because Kako gives his strong message through his book. Nikky: Wow, your mother bought a nice bicycle for you! I'm sure you'll have a wonderful high school life.

Maiko: Thank you. I like it very much. I can't wait to become a high school student!

Nikky: I wish I could be a high school student in Japan next year... Anyway, you should buy a *helmet.

Maiko: A helmet? I know it's better for me to *wear one when I ride a bicycle, but I don't want to.

Nikky: Why?

Maiko: Because I don't think I look cool with a helmet. Also my hair loses its shape.

*Hairstyle is one of the most important things for high school girls!

Nikky: Are there any other reasons?

Maiko: Some of my friends say, "A new law was made and it says it's better to wear a helmet. However, it's not illegal even if we don't wear a helmet." And others say, "Wearing or bringing a helmet is heavy." According to today's newspaper, less than half of Japanese people wear helmets when they ride bicycles.

Nikky: Less than half? In our country, New Zealand, we must wear helmets when we ride bicycles. If we don't, it is illegal.

Maiko: Oh, ①it's strict! So, everybody wears a helmet in your country.

Nikky: Yes, we have to. But some people don't like wearing one, and they have stopped riding bicycles. The number of people who ride bicycles has been decreasing little by little. Some of them have started to use cars instead of bicycles.

Maiko: That's not good. Bicycles are not only cheap and easy to use, but also friendly to the Earth and a *sustainable way of transporting people.

Nikky: You're right.

Maiko: Maybe I want to have a car in the future, but I'm going to ride a bicycle *while I'm a student.

Nikky: You should. You can protect our environment by using a bicycle. As for helmets, I have one more important thing to tell you. You can protect one of the most important parts of your body by wearing a helmet.
